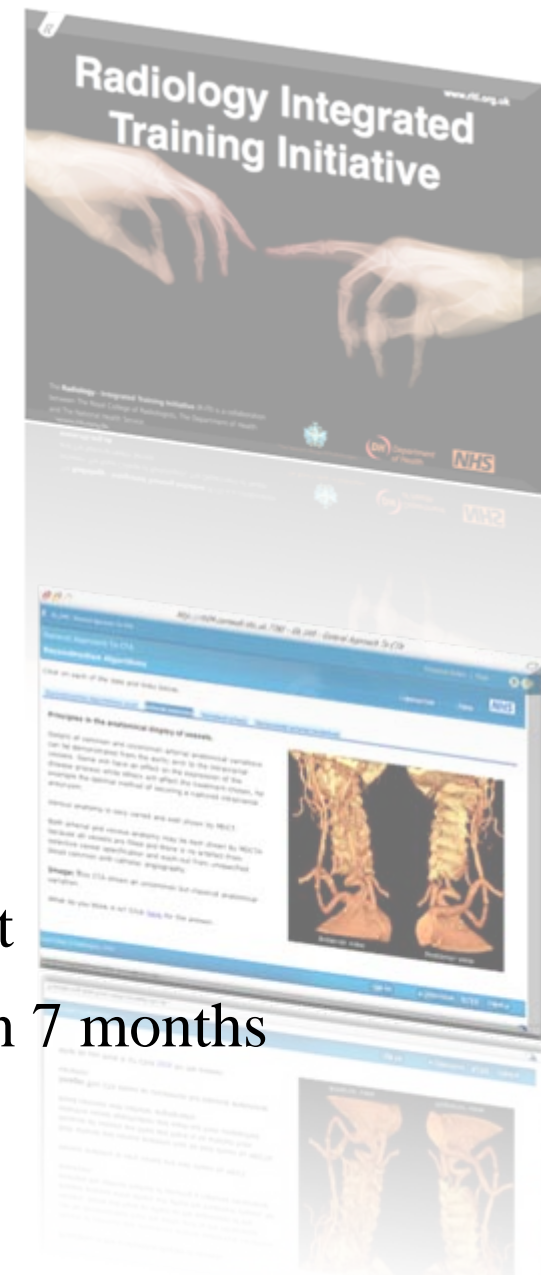
e-Learning for Healthcare

- Department of Health programme
- Partnership with professional bodies and the NHS
- Nationally quality assured e-learning content for UK - wide healthcare workforce
- Underpinned by LMS – lifelong transferable record
- Professional and generic
- Core content for the national LMS



Radiology 2005- 2007

- Rigorous project management
- Entire 3 year curriculum – blended learning
- 350 expert authors
- >600 hours interactive content
- Cost 2% of commercial rates
- Impact –
 - Nationally quality assured content
 - Transformed training and trainer support
 - Trainees reach 15 month standard within 7 months
 - Doubled training capacity
 - Model for all postgraduate training



e-Learning for Healthcare core principles

- All content free to UK healthcare workforce
- All content shared with appropriate professions
- In-house development and shared IPR
- International licensing supports updates
