Please note that Heathrow airport has its own stations on the Piccadilly (dark blue) line which connects passages to the airport and central London. The best route would be from Heathrow travel to Hammersmith station then change onto the Central or Hammersmith and City line (yellow and light pink) and travel to Great Portland Street. From there it is less than a five minute walk to the Melia hotel and Royal College.
